Information at a Glance:

To help you and your crews determine which mobile devices and data plans are the best fit for your businesses, Safeguard's Mobile Applications Team is providing recommendations on what works best with Safeguard's mobile applications.

The mobile device specifications needed to properly run the Vendor Web Mobile and Photo Direct applications include the following minimum capabilities:

- Wi-Fi / Data capable device that runs on a 3G network
- 1GB RAM
- Camera (3.1mp)

The mobile device capabilities our team recommends to optimize the applications include:

- Data (4G)
- Camera Flash

Vendors using Android devices need to have the OS (2.3.3) or newer operating system, while those using iOS devices need to have OS (6) or newer. The recommended mobile devices below have been tested by Safeguard for full functionality with each application.

Android

- ZTE Warp 4G
- Galaxy Note 2
- Motorola Droid RAZR
- Nexus 7
- HTC 1
- Samsung Galaxy S3
- Samsung Galaxy S5

iOS

- iPhone 5S or 5C
- iPad Mini with cellular connection
- iPad 3+ with cellular connection

Safeguard's recommended data plans include a 4G network, which will deliver faster transmission times for transferring data. Carriers vary per region. A helpful site to use to make a decision on which data plan is best for your business is myrateplan.com.

The matrix below will give you an idea of the amount of data you will need per month based on the number of photos you take per day:

Photos (PER DAY)	Data Needed (PER MONTH)
100	.5 GB
200	1 GB
300	1.4 GB
400	1.8 GB
500	2.2 GB
600	2.7 GB
700	3 GB
800	3.5 GB
900	3.9 GB
1000	4.4 GB
